the life of St. Andrew’s School:

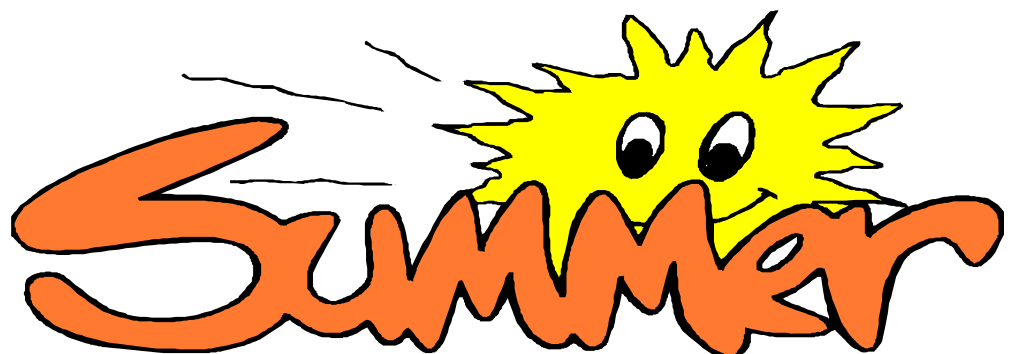
- Polite, respectful, kind to everyone
